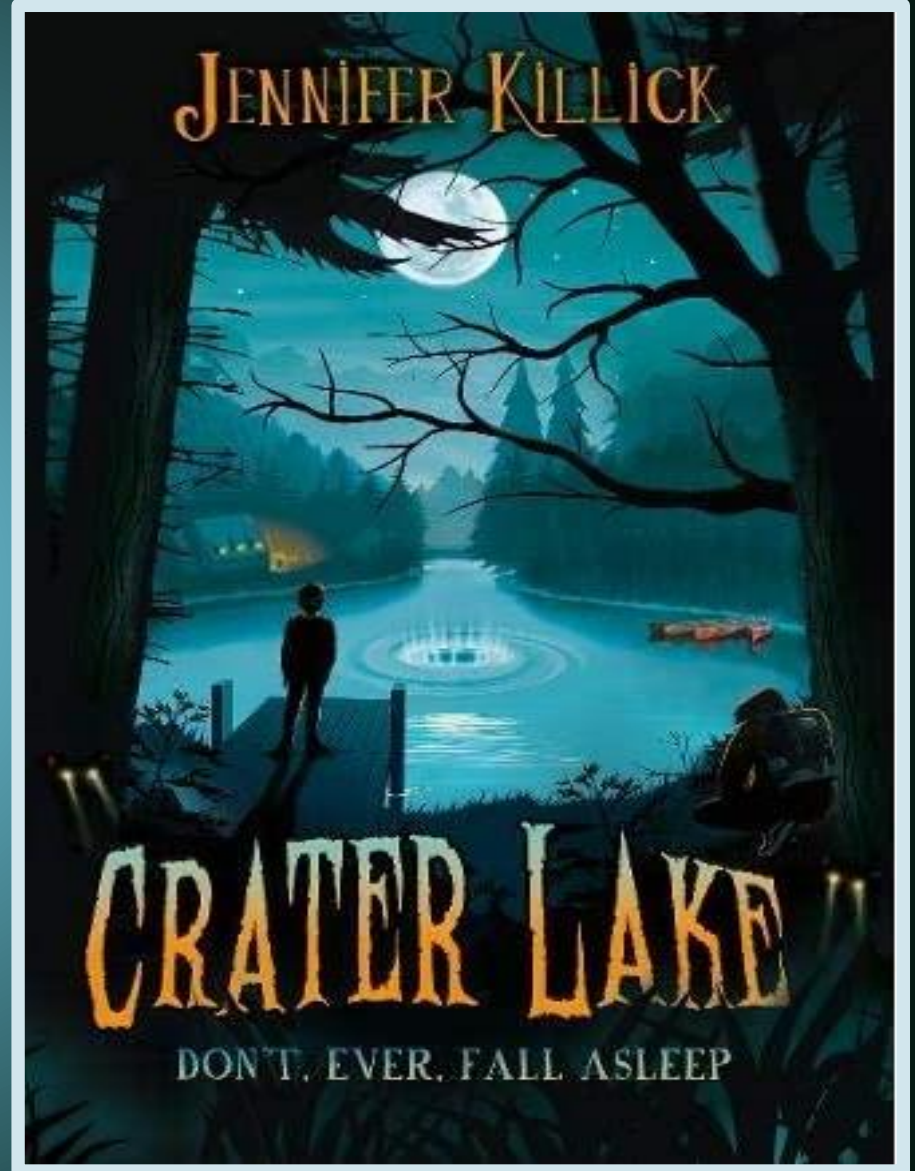


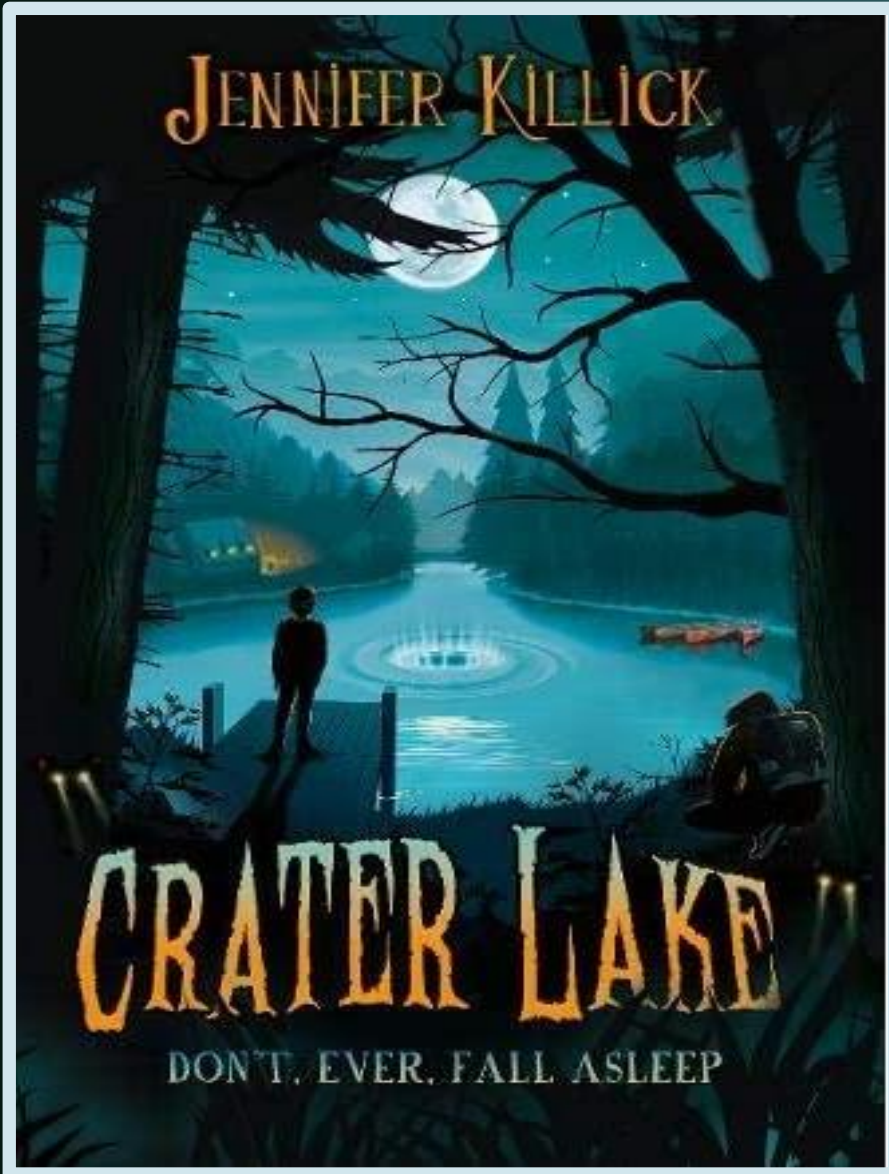

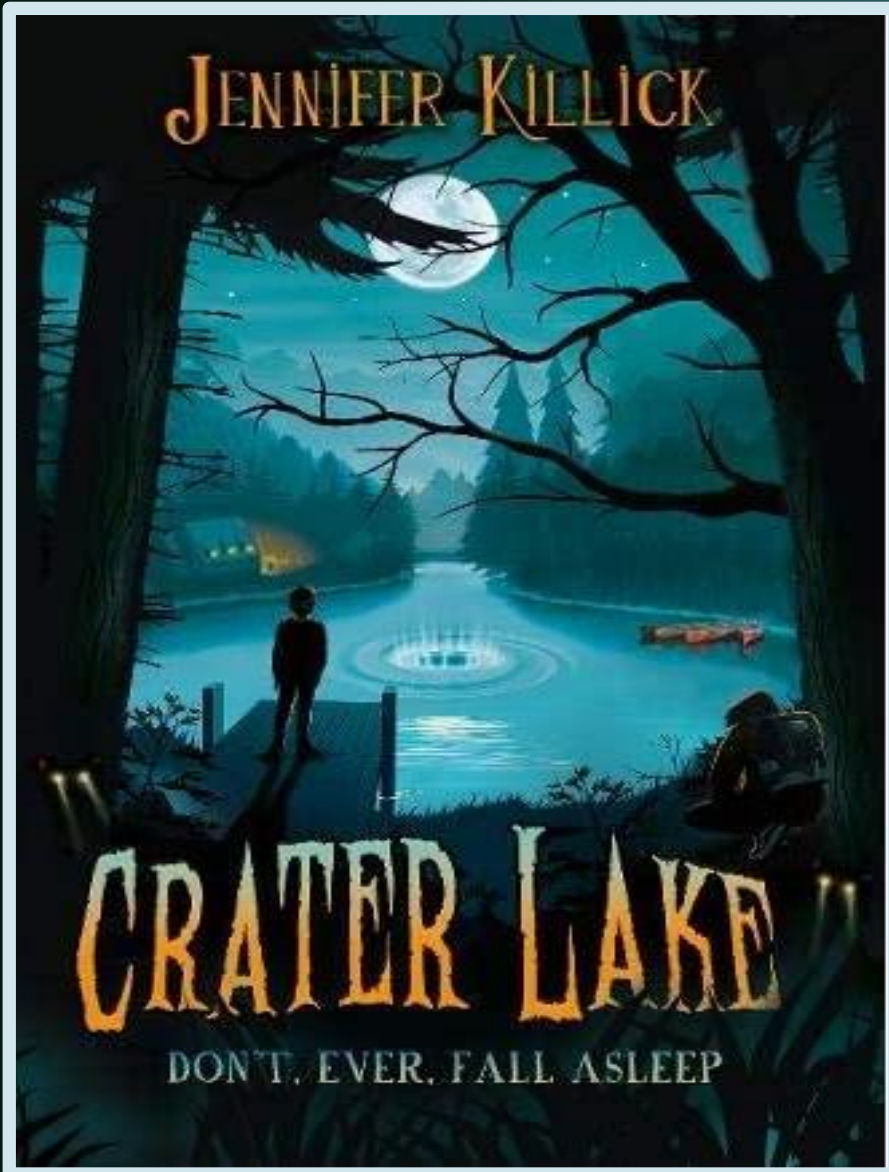

# The Front Cover



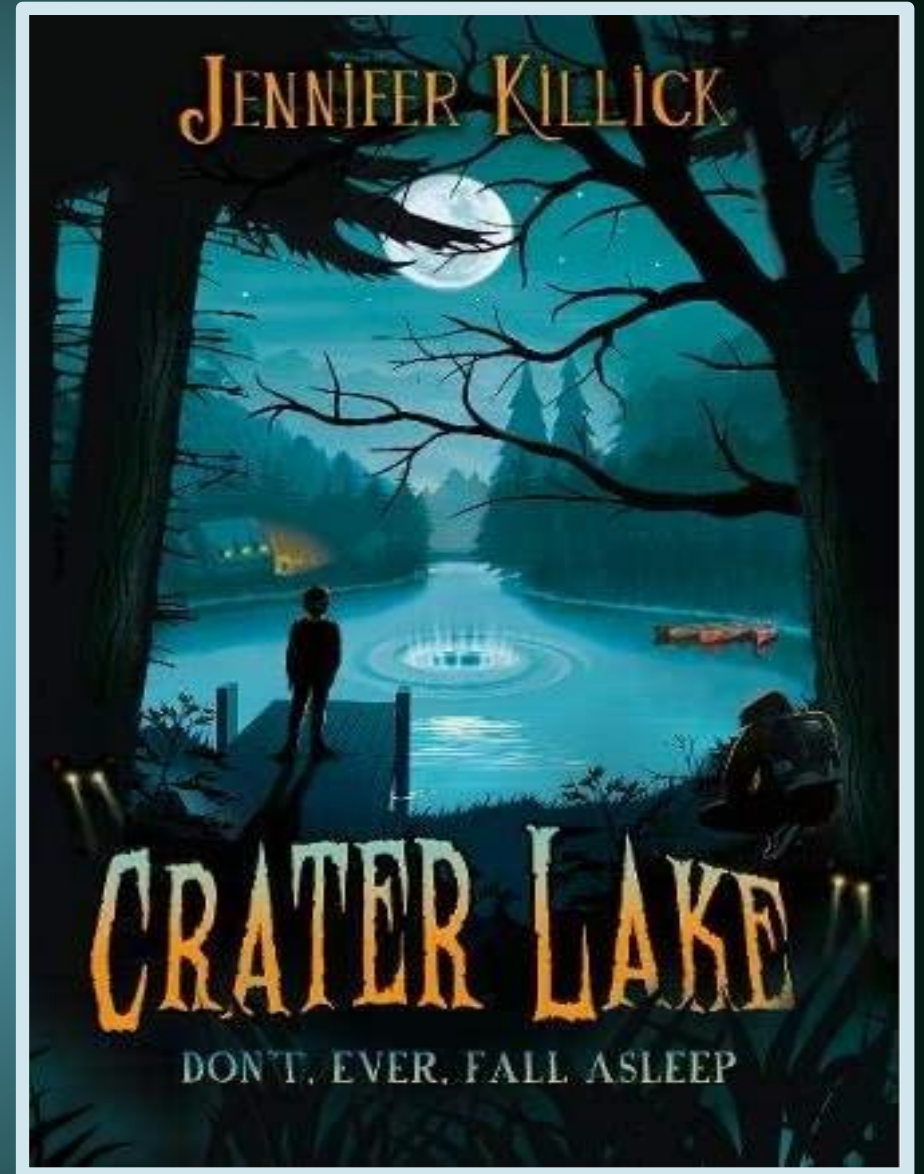


Analyse the front cover of the book. What clues about the plot of the story can you find?

# The First Sentence



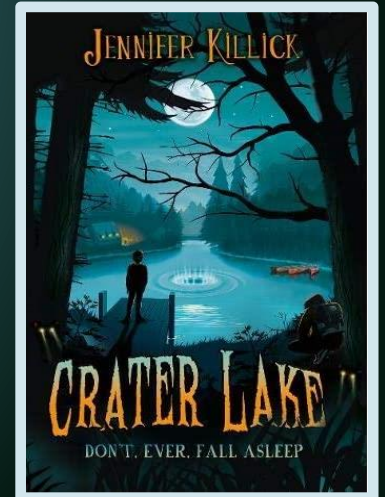

What do you think is going to happen at Crater Lake based on the blurb (and front cover)?

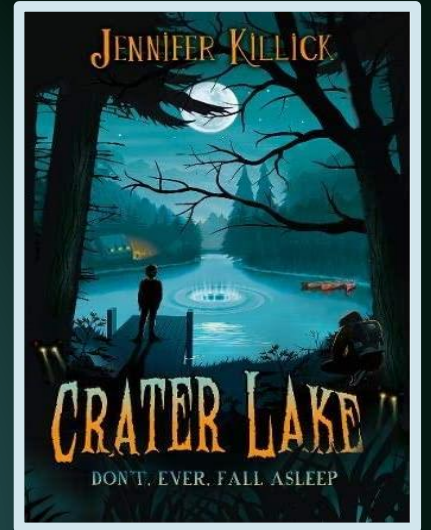

- Why do you think Lance can not be in a room with others? What do you think his ‘personal reasons’ are?

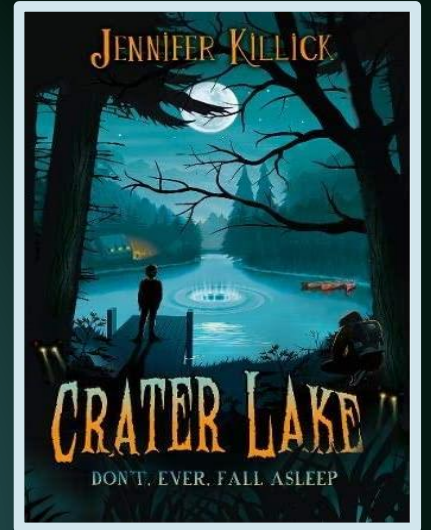

- How has Lance become the leader? What changes have you noticed in his character (even at this early stage of the book)? Use examples and contrasts from the text.



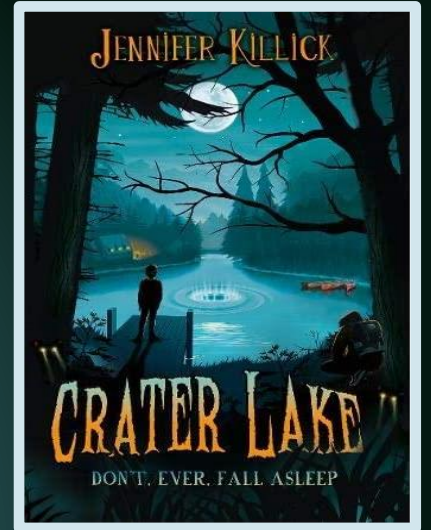
